# First Conditional

## Structure

**IF + Simple Present, Simple Future**

(S + will/won't + V(bare form))

## Usage

**To talk about possibilities in the present  
or in the future**

## Examples

- If it rains, I will stay at home.
- If I wake up late, I will miss the bus.



## MORE EXAMPLES FOR YOU

+

If I study, I will pass my exams.

-

If I don't study, I won't pass my exams.

?

If I study, will I pass my exams?

+

If he studies, he will pass his exams.

-

If he doesn't study, he won't pass his exams.

?

If he studies, will he pass his exams?

## SUMMARY

IF CLAUSE (CAUSE) , + RESULT CLAUSE (EFFECT)

"If I don't complete the homework, Miss Carolina will be angry"

SUBJECT	Affirmative +	Negative -	Interrogative?
I You We They	<b>Subject + Verb (infinitive)...</b>  <b>Ex:</b> I play soccer	<b>Subject + DON'T (auxiliary) + VERB (infinitive)...</b>  <b>Ex:</b> I don't play soccer.	<b>DO (auxiliary) + subject + VERB (infinitive) ...?   Ex: Do I play soccer?</b>
He She It  (3rd person)	<b>Verb (infinitive) + s/es...</b>  <b>Ex:</b> She plays soccer.	<b>Subject + DOESN'T + VERB (infinitive)...</b>  <b>Ex:</b> She doesn't play soccer.	<b>DOES (auxiliary) + subject + VERB (infinitive) ...?   Ex: Does she play soccer?</b>

### FUTURE SIMPLE (FUTURE WILL)

SUBJECT	Affirmative +	Negative -	Interrogative?
I You We They He She It	<b>Subject + WILL+VERB (infinitive)...</b>  <b>Ex:</b> We will stay at home for two weeks.	<b>Subject + WON'T (auxiliary) + VERB (infinitive)...</b>  <b>Ex:</b> We won't stay at home for two weeks.	<b>WILL (auxiliary) + subject + VERB (infinitive) ...?   Ex: Will we estay at home for two weeks?</b>
