**Conditional 2. Complete the sentences of the dialogues with conditional 2.**

**Dialogue 1:**

**Josh:** Hey, Billy, I'm going on a date with a girl I met in my art class last week. Any ideas?

**Billy:** If I **WAS** (be) you I **WOULD TAKE** (take) her to a museum.

**Josh:** That's a good idea, which one do you recommend?

**Billy:** Well, if I **HAD TO** (have to) choose, I **WOULD GO** (go) to the Tale Modern and I **WOULD VISIT** (visit) the North wing, that's where the most interesting paintings are.

**Josh:** What if she gets bored?

**Billy:** If she **GOT** (get) bored with Jackson Pollock's paintings, I **WOULD SUGGEST** (suggest) her to visit Mark Rothko's room.

**Josh:** Maybe she doesn't like modern art.

**Billy:** If she **DIDN'T LIKE** (not/like) modern art, I **WOULD NOT** (not/date) her anymore!!!

**Josh:** If I **WAS** (be) you, I **\_ WOULD TAKE** (take) art so seriously!

**Billy:** and if I **WAS** (be) you, I **WOULDN'T** (not/date) so many girls.

## Dialogue 2:

**Derek:** If you **WERE** (be) more punctual, we **WOULDN'T ARRIVE** (not/arrive) late everywhere!

**Rebecca:** If I **FINISHED** (finish) work earlier, I **WOULD BE** (be) ready before, but you know I always finish at eight o'clock.

**Derek:** Yes, but if you **ASKED** (ask) your boss to let you leave half an hour before we **WOULD MEET** (meet) our friends on time.

**Rebecca:** If you **WANTED** (want) to meet our friends on time, you **COULD PICK** (can/pick) me up from work so I **WOULDN'T HAVE** (not/have) to take a bus home.

**Derek:** If I **PICKED** (pick) you up from work, I **WOULD NOT HAVE** (not/have) time to change clothes.

**Rebecca:** If you **LOVED** (love) me, you **WOULD WORRY** (worry) about me!

**Derek:** If you **DIDN'T ACT** (not/act) like a child, you **WOULD** (understand) me.

**Rebecca:** and if you **WERE NOT** (not/be) so selfish, you **WOULD KNOW** (know) why I am angry at you now!

**Derek:** I give up! Let's go. They're waiting for us.

**Conditional 3: Rewrite the following sentences using conditional 3.**

1. Lucía didn't go to school last Monday because she was ill

If Lucia hadn't been ill , she would have gone to school last Monday.

2. I didn't cook dinner yesterday evening because my husband brought pizza.

If my husband hadn't brought pizza , I would have cooked dinner yesterday evening.

3. My father wasn't at home last night because he had an important meeting at the office.

If my father hadn't had an important meeting at the office , he would have been at home last night

4. Peter went out with his friends because he finished his homework on time.

If Peter hadn't finished his homework on time , he wouldn't have gone out with his friends.

5. We were late for work yesterday morning so the boss was very angry with us.

If we hadn't been late for work yesterday morning , the boss wouldn't have been angry with us.

6. David and Claire didn't buy the house on Park Street because it didn't have a balcony.

If the house on Park Street had had a balcony , David and Claire would have bought it.

7. I couldn't get into the house because I forgot the key in the classroom.

If I hadn't forgotten the key in the classroom , I could have got into the house.

**8.** Mr. Jenkins drove his car carelessly. He crashed into a tree

If Mr. Jenkins hadn't driven his car carelessly , he wouldn't have crashed into a tree

**9.** Miss Eliot left her umbrella at home so she got soaked in the heavy rain last Sunday.

If Miss Eliot hadn't left her umbrella at home , she wouldn't have got soaked in the heavy rain last Sunday.

**10.** Little boy refused to use the suncream. He had a terrible sunburn on his shoulders.

If the little boy hadn't refused to use the suncream , he wouldn't have had terrible sunburn on his shoulders.

**11.** I didn't have my trainers with me so I couldn't play basketball with my friends.

If I had had my trainers with me , I could have played basketball with my friends.

**12.** Helen couldn't telephone her friend James because she didn't know the telephone number.

If Helen had known the telephone number , she could have helped her friend James.
